PUBLIC FORUM George Kersh reiterated previous suggestions that the position of Police

Chief be filled by an in-house appointment, that the Police Department be directed to issue a daily police log for public inspection and that department heads be requested to report on activities at each Council meeting. In particular, he stated that debris piles have remained uncollected in front of his house for weeks and he requested that the

Public Works Department remove this debris.

REGULAR CALENDAR The Council considered the following items of regular business:

Crime Report The Acting Police Chief submitted Piedmont crime statistics for 2008,

noting that overall the crime rate is relatively low but that "crimes of opportunity" have increased over last year's level. At the request of the

Council, the Acting Chief provided suggestions for how residents can reduce the likelihood that they will become victims of "crimes of opportunity," noting that these tips as well as other crime prevention suggestions can be found on the City's website. The Council discussed the report, requesting that future reports be submitted to the Council on a quarterly basis and if possible, statistics related to burglaries indicate whether the burglaries were committed while residents were "at home" or "away." Councilmember Keating voiced his preference that the police log be updated weekly on the City's website.

Ordinance

The Fire Chief submitted for Council first reading approval proposed Ordinance 684 N.S. mandating service levels for non-emergency private ambulance providers in accordance with regulations established by Alameda County. The Chief stated that these regulations are mandated by Alameda County and are being adopted countywide. The City Administrator noted a few minor revisions to the submitted ordinance and concurred with the Chief's recommendation.

RESOLVED, that the City Council approves the first reading of Ordinance 684 N.S., as revised, mandating service levels established by Alameda County for any private ambulance provider located or providing service within the City of Piedmont.
