RECOMMENDATION:

By motion, award contract to Weco, Industries, Vallejo in the amount of \$164,300 for the purchase of a truck mounted Sewer Equipment Company of America (SECA) Model 800-HPR Sewer Hydro Flusher.

BACKGROUND:

Currently, the City operates one (1) sewer flusher, which is the primary piece of sewer cleaning equipment used on a daily basis by the maintenance staff for routine flushing of sewers as well as clearing blockages during emergencies. Given the daily usage by staff, the life span of a flusher is approximately ten (10) years. The last flushers purchased by the City were in 1985 and 1995. Since 2004, the existing flusher has exhibited transmission slippage, leakage in the main water tank, power loss in the main water pump and engine power loss especially while traveling up hills with a full water tank.

As authorized by Chapter 2, Section 2.154 (n) of the Piedmont City Code, the City may take advantage of a previous public bid. It is proposed that the City purchase the sewer hydro flusher unit utilizing the City of Concord bid and the chassis upon which the flusher sits utilizing the City of Los Altos bid. As is normal practice, the mating of the flusher and the chassis will be accomplished by the flusher manufacturer, WECO Industries.
