DOG LICENSE REGISTRATION & OFF- LEASH PERMIT

RESIDENT & NON RESIDENT

Dog License

Dogs are required to be licensed at 4 months of age or within 10 days of ownership or bringing the animal into the City of Piedmont. A significant penalty may be assessed for delinquencies. **A dog license can only be issued for the duration of the current rabies vaccination.** Animal Services Officers cannot issue a dog license to non-residents.

Off Leash Permit

For use in authorized "off-leash" areas in the City of Piedmont: Blair Park in its entirety, Piedmont Park creek area, and Dracena Park pathway. All areas are designated by signs. All dogs must be on leash coming to and leaving designated off-leash areas.

Non-Resident Off-Leash Permits

Non-resident off-leash permits will only be issued in one-year increments. Applicants must provide proof of a current dog license from city of residence.
